

1. COACH BOAT USE

Dragon Boat Teams, Flatwater and Outrigger Programs may book FCRCC Coach Boats up to one week in advance through the FCRCC Administrator (admin@fcrcc.com).

1.1. Who can use which Coach Boats¹

For the Alder Bay coach boats, no specific coach boat will be assigned at the time of booking. The Burrard coach boat can be specifically booked for a session.

1.2. Certification

The coach boat pilot must possess a valid Pleasure Craft Operator Card and carry it with them when operating the coach boat. A copy of the Pleasure Craft licence card must be submitted to the FCRCC office prior to boat operation. (admin@fcrcc.com)

All coach boat users must successfully complete the FCRCC coach boat orientation provided by the Program Co-ordinator or her designated representative.

The FCRCC will provide coach boat orientation sessions upon request by a Team or Program leader.

The Program Coordinator will keep a registry of all FCRCC certified coach boat operators.

1.3. Operation and Damage

All coach boat users must log in prior to using a coach boat and log out after return of boat and motor.

The team and coach must take full responsibility for damage and loss to the boat and motor. If a motor is dropped into salt water, it is deemed lost. A waiver acknowledging this must be signed by the team captain and manager acknowledging this responsibility before a coach boat is reserved.

1.4. Reservations

All use of the coach boats must be reserved ahead of time. Coach boat requests should be made on line. (see the FCRCC website Members area – Boat Reservation. The coach boat schedule will be posted on the FCRCC website. See Members area – coach boat schedule.

Dragon boat teams will indicate, upon team registration, whether they wish to use the coach boat at each practice, upon request, or will not use coach boat.

Outrigger teams are asked to send their request for coach boat at least one month in advance.

Coach boats required for an event must be booked in advance and the event organizers must ensure the driver has met the club requirements.

Individuals requesting the use of the new coach boat must contact the Equipment representative for further information and orientation
